### **QURAN ASSESSMENT OVERVIEW**

#### Class 1: Ages 5-6 Quran:

**Quran:** Recognition of all Arabic letters (huroof) in and out of alphabetical order. Recognition of letters in their various forms; beginning, middle, and end. Hifdh(Memorisation)Surahs: Al-Fatihah, Al-Ikhlas, Al-Falaq and An-Naas

# Class 2: Ages 6-7 (Child is expected to know more than a few topics)

**Quran:** Joining of letters, Selfish letters, Harakah (short vowels), Tanween. Hifdh (memorisation) Surah Fatihah, Al-Masad, Al-Nasr and Al-Kauthar.

## Class 3: Ages 7-8 (Child is expected to know more than a few topics)

**Quran**: year 1 and year 2 topics plus Madd (long vowels), Sukun, Qalqalah, Huroof (letters) of Leen, Hamzah with Sukun, Shaddah.

## Class 4: Ages 8-9 (Child is expected to know more than a few topics)

**Quran**: Revise class 3 topics, Madd (long vowels), Maddah, Muqatta'at, Hamzatul-wasl, Definite Article, Pronunciation of Allah (swt), stopping at the end of an ayah and pausing signs. Begin Reading Quran: Juzz Amma. Hifdh (memorisation) Surah Fatihah, At-Takathur, Al-Qariah, Al-'Adiyat, Az-Zalzalah.

### Class 5: Ages 9-10 (Child is expected to know more than a few topics)

**Quran**: Revise Class 4 topics. Special signs and fine points, Ghunnah, Rules of noon saakin and tanween, stopping at the end of an ayah, and pausing signs. Reading Quran: Surah Al-Baqarah, putting all rules into practice during recitation.

## Class 6: Ages 10-11 (Child is expected to know more than a few topics)

**Quran:** Revise Class 4 topics. Special signs and fine points, Ghunnah, Rules of noon saakin and tanween, stopping at the end of an ayah, and pausing signs. Reading Quran: Surah Al-Baqarah, putting all rules into practice during recitation. Continue reading Quran. Revise all rules and put them into practice during recitation.
